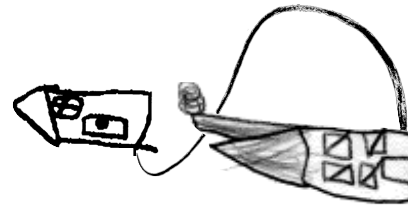
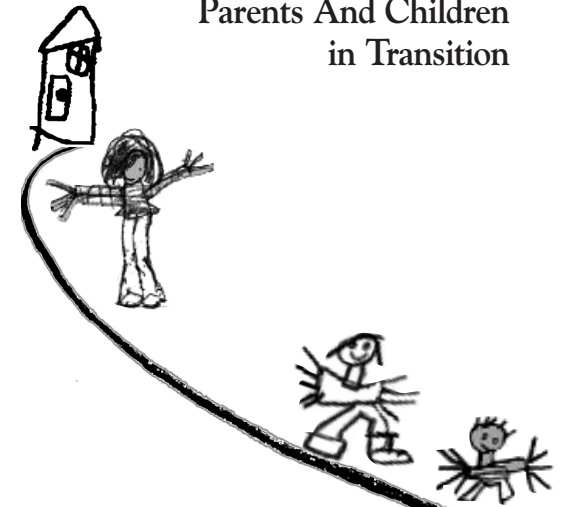

This five-hour parent education program focuses on the needs of children when parents live apart. PACT addresses issues relevant to

- divorcing parents of minor children
- previously divorced parents
- parents who anticipate living separately

Both of the two-and-a-half hour sessions are facilitated by a male/female team of child development and parent education specialists and consist of video, presentation and discussion. The program is open to the public upon registration.

Topics Include

- Problem solving
- Cooperative parenting
- Pitfalls for parents to avoid
- What children need to know
- What parents can do to help children adjust
- Reactions of children when parents live apart

Certificates: Certificates of attendance will be distributed at the end of the second session. PACT will deliver your certificate to the Hampshire County Probate and Family Court if your docket number is provided.

Parents are required to attend separate sessions.
